THE EQUESTRIAN CENTER AT BEVERLY FARM

The Equestrian Center offers a full-service horse boarding stable, and opportunities for community riding programs. One of only a handful of facilities in the region, the Equestrian Center at Beverly Farm is truly unique.

The horses used in the Equestrian Center Program are trained to accept all calibers of riders safely. The horses vary in breed and size. Before working in the program, each horse receives extensive training to evaluate its potential and allow the horse time to adjust to its new surroundings and expected tasks.

The Equestrian Center features an indoor center arena that measures 141' x 60 feet. The indoor arena features a shredded recycled rubber surface. The round training pen measures 60' in diameter and has a sand surface. Tack and handling equipment are available for use during training lessons. Safety riding helmets and merchandise are also available for purchase.

There are eleven pine stalls with strong steel gates in the main arena. The alleyways are matted for both safety and accessibility. There is a special ADA compliant mounting ramp inside the arena that makes it easy for riders to mount safely.

RIDING PROGRAMS & PUBLIC LESSONS

The Equestrian Center at Beverly Farm offers horseback riding lessons for anyone five years of age and older. Riders participate in lessons to increase their riding skills and improve their knowledge of horses in general. The program instructs riders in horsemanship, saddling, unsaddling, and general horse care.

PUBLIC BOARDING

Public boarding is available by special approval through an application process. Horses are turned out for the majority of the day and night to enjoy the pasture. Several run-ins provide shelter from inclement weather, and enclosed lots with individual run-ins are also available. Horses receive individual feeding twice a day.
